Guidelines for Submissions All manuscripts should be original and previously unpublished. The primary language of *Septet* is English, but articles in fields primarily taught in other languages may be accepted in Turkish or other languages at the discretion of the editors. Submissions should be approximately 5000 to 7000 words in Word format. They should be formatted in APA style, unless otherwise requested by the guest editor. All articles will undergo double-blind peer review. Copies should be submitted simultaneously by email to the editor-in-chief and the guest editor, with all personal information removed.
